Our school community has also further developed "Muir Model" practices and social-emotional learning to develop citizenship skills and positive behaviors.

Area for Growth

Across the 2017-2018 school year, instructional practices will center on the learning and implementation of a new math curriculum called, Bridges. Our staff will use strengths in collaborative practices to support each other and engage our students through this new learning. We will also focus on reading foundational skills and general school safety to support learning and our school climate.

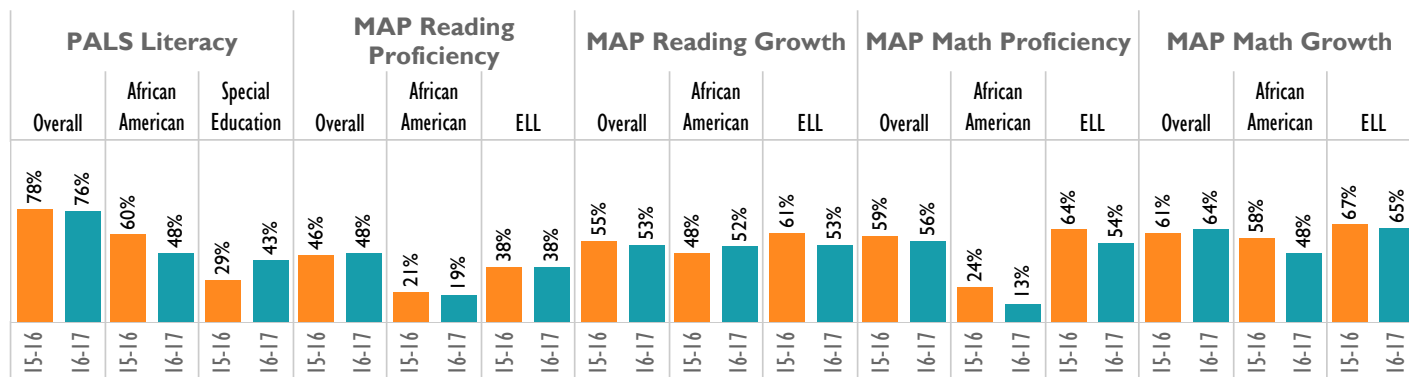

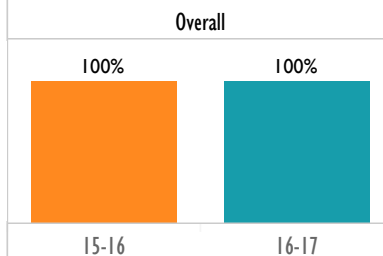
Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate
